

1. Electrostatic Disinfecting







ELECTROSTATIC DISINFECTING

Electrostatic cleaning is the process of spraying an electrostatically charged mist onto surfaces and objects. Electrostatic spray uses a disinfectant solution that is combined with air and atomized by an electrode inside the sprayer. This positively charges particles so that they aggressively adhere to surfaces and objects, clinging to and fully coating any surface that they are aimed at, including hard to reach places, thus applying chemicals in a more efficient, controlled manner and maximizing coverage of disinfectants. This makes electrostatic spraying an effective method of neutralizing contaminants including bacteria, viruses and other blood-borne pathogens, such as influenza and COVID-19.

Note: For this service the client is responsible to make sure all areas are dust and residue free to ensure effectiveness of electrostatic spraying.



ELECTROSTATIC DISINFECTING SCOPE OF WORK

- Planned Companies will provide all necessary labor and materials, including electrostatic spraying machines, to perform our obligations as set forth in this service agreement.
- Our team of trained professionals will arrive at your property with all necessary personal protective equipment (PPE) to safely and securely perform the disinfecting services requested.
- All equipment used by our teams is disinfected prior to transport to client site and immediately upon service completion before leaving, preventing cross contamination between sites.
- Note: In order for electrostatic disinfecting to be effective, all surfaces must be adequately pre-cleaned to ensure there is no dust, debris or residue that may interfere with the disinfectant mist's ability to adhere to surfaces.
- Once our team has verified that the areas have been adequately prepped and pre-cleaned by property staff, they can begin the process of electrostatic spraying.

- The electrostatic spraying machines use a CDC approved virucide to effectively eradicate all contaminants in vicinity of the service.
- Our associates will spray all areas of a desired space, spraying high to low and left to right, until all areas are covered in disinfectant mist. The nature of the mist allows it to coat surfaces evenly and envelope objects, even if the mist is only sprayed from one side, tackling all of the hard to reach areas such as crevices, corners or awkwardly shaped objects.
- As our associates proceed through the room, we will ensure the mist is within reach of areas including, but not limited to:
 - Ceiling Vents
 - Walls, if they are water resistant
 - Horizontal/Vertical Surfaces
 - Floors
 - Fixtures
 - Elevator Buttons (if applicable)
 - Tables, Desks, & Chairs
- Once our teams have adequately provided disinfectant to all desired areas, they will properly dispose of all contaminated supplies and materials, including PPE, before closing off the space to allow ample time for the disinfectant to seep into surfaces and eradicate contaminants.
- We will provide all management and oversight of site associates, ensuring quality control over all aspects of your disinfection services.



After cleaning has been completed, our team will commence electrostatic disinfecting to tackle all desired areas including hard to reach spots such as crevices, corners or awkwardly shaped objects.

The nature of the mist allows it to coat surfaces evenly and envelope objects, even if the mist is only sprayed from one side, effectively eradicating contaminants.



Once the space has been pre-cleaned by our team, they will disinfect using a CDC approved disinfectant. Once the disinfectant has had ample time to dwell and kill the contaminants, our cleaners will wipe down the areas before beginning the process of electrostatic spraying to tackle all of the hard to reach areas such as crevices, corners or awkwardly shaped objects. The nature of the mist allows it to coat surfaces evenly and envelope objects - even if the mist is only sprayed from one side.

After servicing our associates will dispose of any contaminated materials and PPE before closing off the space to prevent further entry while the chemicals seep into all crevices and surfaces to disinfect.





Did You Know?

While cleaning, sanitizing and disinfecting may sometimes be perceived as interchangeable verbs, there are distinct differences between these methods and thus their effectiveness, that you should be aware of. This will ensure that you are utilizing the proper method for your property's specific needs:

Cleaning removes germs, dirt and impurities from surfaces or objects. Cleaning works by using soap (or detergent) and water to physically remove germs from surfaces. This process does not necessarily kill germs, but by removing them it lowers their numbers and the risk of spreading infection.

Sanitizing *lowers* the number of germs on surfaces or objects to a safe level, as judged by public health standards or requirements. This process works by either cleaning or disinfecting surfaces or objects to lower the risk of spreading infection.

Disinfecting *kills* germs on surfaces or objects. Disinfecting works by using chemicals to kill germs on surfaces or objects, including bacteria, viruses or other contaminants. This process does not necessarily clean dirty surfaces or remove germs, but by killing germs on a surface after cleaning, it can further reduce the risk of spreading infection.

Note: In order to disinfect you must (1) Clean, and then (2) Disinfect.
