- 92% of teachers do not have the resources they need to run a remote learning program

“Students across the country are cut off from their teachers and classroom materials, and students’ home circumstances will affect learning to an even greater degree,” said Charles Best, founder of DonorsChoose. “As coronavirus threatens to widen education inequality, our mission is more vital than ever. We’re grateful for the generosity of Equitable Foundation, which will allow us to help teachers keep their students learning.”
