School Union 76 would like to extend an invitation to apply for the open position of Superintendent of Schools.

School Union 76 is comprised of four towns along the Eggemoggin Reach, a renowned sailing area. Boat-building, the pre-eminent lobster port of Stonington, a well-established arts community, and stunning nature describe the area. It is off the beaten tourist path, but appreciated by year-round residents and a healthy summer community.

School Union 76 provides central services for the island community of Deer Isle and Stonington, located across the Deer Isle Bridge, and the coastal communities of Brooklin and Sedgwick. The Deer Isle-Stonington CSD contains an elementary school and high school on a single campus. Deer Isle-Stonington High School has developed a reputation for connecting community resources with student interests via hands on, project-based learning.

Brooklin and Sedgwick each have their own PreK-8 school. The majority of their secondary students enroll at George Stevens Academy, a private high school in neighboring Blue Hill. The current student population is 445.

The Superintendent also provides contract service to the island community of Isle Au Haut, which is not part of Union 76.

Each community has its own board and negotiates their own budget, professional, and support staff contracts. Budget was \$11,145,041 this year.

Due to the compact nature of the Union and the small central office staff, the ideal candidate will be well-rounded in all aspects of school administration. The successful candidate must possess strong financial and leadership skills, be an educational leader in curriculum/professional development, be actively engaged with the community, and be an effective communicator.
